I understand the TTB is considering requiring additional information on the labels for wine that would include carbohydrate, allergen, and calorie content.

I urge the TTB to determine first if the technology is available for small wineries to be able to analyze their wines for the proposed requirements with a reasonable cost. At this time my winery does not have the necessary laboratory set up to test for carbohydrates and calorie content of my wines and I do not believe the equipment is easily available to purchase.

Secondly I believe the TTB should define what allergens they want wineries to test for and see if these tests are technologically feasible and available to small wineries. We should know what allergens are under consideration and if they are common in wines before requiring tests for them.
