FORMS AVAILABILITY

Federal firearms licensees and explosives licensees and permittees; proprietors of distilled spirits plants, bonded wine cellars, taxpaid wine bottling houses, volatile fruit-flavor concentrate plants, export warehouses, and vinegar plants, brewers; dealers in and users of specially denatured alcohol, reproducers of specially denatured alcohol articles; users of tax-free alcohol; manufacturers of tobacco products, cigarette papers and tubes, and nonbeverage (drawback) products, importers; wholesale dealers in alcoholic beverages; manufacturers of liquor bottles; and others concerned:

ATF F 1600.8: To expedite orders for firearms forms (e.g. ATF F 4473 - Parts 1 and 2) Requisition for Firearms Forms, ATF F 1600.8 may be used. This form should be completed with the requestor's name and return street address on the shipping label portion.
